Administrative leave on Monday, November 2, 2009

Honorable Rhys S. Hodge, Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the Virgin Islands, wishes to advise the general public and members of the Virgin Islands Bar that in observance of D. Hamilton Jackson Day, the employees of the Supreme Court of the Virgin Islands have been granted administrative leave on **Monday, November 2, 2009**. Accordingly, the Court's facilities will be closed on both islands. All filings will be accepted via a secured lockbox at the entrance of the Supreme Court's premises at 100 Blackbeard's Hill, Suite 10, on St. Thomas and No. 18 Strand Street, Frederiksted, on St. Croix.

Relocation of the Supreme Court Offices

Chief Justice Hodge also advises the general public and the Virgin Islands Bar that effective **Tuesday, November 3, 2009**, the Supreme Court of the Virgin Islands will relocate its offices on the island of St. Thomas from its present location at No. 100 Blackbeard's Hill, Suite 10 to Crown Bay No. 161B, which was formerly occupied by the Little Switzerland Corporation.
